



Sprouts!

Helpful Growing Tips

- ✿ Soak paper in water for an hour.
- ✿ Place Sprouts! paper under a light layer of soil.
- ✿ Water Well.
- ✿ Place in a warm sunny area.
- ✿ Keep moist until germinated.
- ✿ Plant indoors or out.

Constant moisture is the key to successfully growing Sprouts! flowers!

Be sure to water your Sprouts! everyday, and if you live in a dry climate, possibly a few times a day until the seeds germinate.

Here is another method for germinating your Sprouts! paper:

Dampen your Sprouts! paper, and wrap it in a wet paper towel. Put the paper towel in a plastic bag, and leave the bag unsealed to allow for air circulation. Place the plastic bag in a warm place, and monitor the paper towels moisture level. If the paper towel begins to dry out, simply dampen it again. In a week or two, your Sprouts! will begin to grow!

When the seeds have germinated, carefully plant the seedlings along with the Sprouts! paper in a pot of high quality potting soil. If roots have grown into the paper towel, cut or tear apart the paper towel and plant it in the soil along with the seedlings.

Set your newly potted Sprouts! flowers in a warm sunny location, either in or out of doors, and water often.
